Malt whisky: A whisky produced solely from malted barley, yeast and water - whisky is essentially distilled beer. Single malts come from just one distillery, single cask malts from just one cask, while blended malts are from more than one distillery. Blended Scotch whisky: A mix of malt whiskies and whiskies made from whole grains other than barley. Other types of whisky (or whiskey in the US and Ireland) such as American bourbon have their own specific production and grain requirements.
